

What are cookies?

As you browse our site, we use various technologies to provide you with a personalized and seamless experience. One of these technologies is cookies.

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by websites that you visit. They allow us to remember your preferences, improve your browsing experience, and provide us with important analytics about our site's usage.

At our company, we take your privacy very seriously, and we want to be transparent about how we use cookies on our website. In this cookie statement, we explain what cookies are, how we use them, and how you can manage them. Please read this statement carefully to understand our practices and how they may affect your experience on our site.

Each time you visit our website, you will be asked to accept or decline cookies.

How do we use cookies?

Visitor preferences cookies

These are cookies that are used to remember user preferences and settings, such as language preference, font size, or whether the visitor has accepted (or rejected) the site's cookie policy.

Improving experience cookies

These are cookies that are used to enhance the user experience by providing personalized content and recommendations based on a visitor's browsing history and preferences. For example, if you visit a website that offers product recommendations based on your previous purchases, an improving experience cookie may be used to remember those purchases and suggest related products that you may be interested in. These types of cookies can help make a website feel more relevant and tailored to each visitor's needs.

Measurement cookies

We use Google Analytics to collect information about how visitors use a website, such as which pages they visit most often, how long they stay on the site, and what links they click on. This information is typically used to analyze and improve the performance of the website, as well as to understand how visitors interact with the site and what content is most popular. If you do not allow the use of these cookies, we will not know when you visited the site and will not be able to assess whether it worked properly or not.

How to manage cookies?

When you visit a website, you may be asked to give your consent to the use of cookies. If you do not give your consent, some parts of the website may not work as expected. After enabling cookies, you can also do the following actions:

- **Delete cookies from your device**

You can delete the cookies you already have on your device by deleting the browser history. This will delete cookies from all the websites you have visited. However, you may also lose some of the information you have stored, such as your login IDs or website preferences.

- **Manage cookies on a particular site**

Most web browsers allow you to control the use of cookies through their settings. You can typically find these settings in the "Options" or "Preferences" menu of your browser. From there, you may be able to choose whether to accept all cookies, reject all cookies, or accept cookies only from certain websites.

- **Block cookies**

It is possible to set most browsers to not accept cookies on the device you are using but, in that case, you may have to manually set a number of preferences each time you visit a site or page.

Changes in our Cookie Policy

We may update the Cookie Policy of our website from time to time. Therefore, we recommend that you review this policy each time you access our website to be properly informed about how and for what purpose we use cookies.
